Throughout my calling, I have been committed to reconciling, with the help that the Spirit provides, the duality between the proclamation of the gospel in word and sacrament and the demonstration of the gospel as exemplified in charitable giving, economic empowerment, and social justice. In connection with this reconciliation is the Circuit's mission statement, summarised in the strap line, 'Loving Others as God Loves us', which grounds its missional practice.
