As you may be aware some of our Circuit email accounts have been hacked and you may have received emails saying that you have 2 protected messages and to open a voicemail.

Please do not click on any part of this email, please delete these emails. If you have clicked on anything in the fraudulent email this will replicate information from your personal account and this email may be compromised, you will need to let your contacts know that your account has been compromised. If you have clicked on anything in the fraudulent email please reset you password.

The situation has now been rectified and extra security measures have been put in place to help prevent this happening again.

Please be vigilant if you ever get any emails with links – don't click on any links unless you're sure they are legitimate, even if the email address appears legitimate.
