[‘Hidden Hardship: Everyday experience, coping strategies, and barriers to wellbeing in rural Britain’](#) is a participatory research project funded by the British Academy that has examined people’s experiences of hardship in the rural North Cotswolds.

The exhibition will launch in the Chapel of Unity at Coventry Cathedral on Tuesday 30th January 2024 from 3pm – 4.30pm.
